


About SGI

In the year 2009, SVVR Educational Society established Food and Agri-Business School (SGI-FABS) - the first such non-government institute in erstwhile Andhra Pradesh, at Hyderabad, now Telangana state. "FLAME OF THE FOREST"

The 'Flame of Forest' campus of Sagar Group of Institutions is located at Chevella town, 45 kilometers from the city of Hyderabad, Telangana. The campus is named after the beautiful 'Flame of Forest' trees that grows in this area. The campus is 50kms from Rajiv Gandhi International Airport and 50kms from Secundrabad railway station. 'Flame of Forest' is a sprawling 50-acre integrated campus which has been divided into an 18 acres bit comprising of infrastructure such as academic blocks, canteen, library, hostels etc. and a 32 acres bit that is dedicated to farming and field work for students to enable live practical learning.

Sports Committee



Admission Process & Eligibility







- Step 2: Agri Aptitude Test- Date will be announced by the admissions team
- Step 3: Candidates who have cleared the Agri Aptitude Test will have to appear for a personal or telephonic interview after paying Rs/-500 for the application form. Please note, you will also have to clear any one of the following: CAT/MAT/CMAT/ATMA/GMAT/XAT.
- Step 4: An Admission letter will be sent to short-listed candidates based on the test & Interview performance.
- Step 5: Selected candidate has to pay Rs.25000/- towards confirmation of provisional admission.
- Step 6: Admission list will be prepared.

Eligibility Criteria

- Minimum qualification for admission to the PGDM Agri Business Management program is UGC/ICAR recognized graduation, in any discipline with a minimum CGPA of 5.00 out of 10.00 or 50% aggregate marks or their equivalent. Final year students can also apply.
- Candidates having inclination to agribusiness will be preferred.
- Should have appeared for CAT/MAT/CMAT/ATMA/GMAT/XAT.




